

RULES AND REGULATIONS

No animal or articles will be allowed to compete for more than one premium.

Early entries receive preference as to pens and stalls.

The books will be open for entry of articles a month before the fair. All entries open to the State except 4-H Club exhibits open to Greeley County only.

Proof of breeding of all purebred animals must be furnished if required

No two members of any one family or farm shall show livestock except in Poultry or 4-H departments, in competition with each other

An exhibitor attempting to interfere with the judges will be promptly excluded from the competition.

Diligence will be used by the officers of the Board to prevent injury to animals or articles on exhibition, but will not be responsible for any damage that might occur. Superintendents are not responsible for feed.

Exhibitors and visitors will take notice that the society will not be liable for any damage or accident that might occur to anyone, or for the loss of property, but the officers will use diligence to avoid any accidents and afford protection.

The association reserves the right to call off races or other entertainment on account of bad weather or other unavoidable causes.

No exhibit shall be removed from the grounds until 4:00 pm of the last day of the fair without the consent of the President and General Superintendent.

No animal shall be removed from the grounds until 10:00 am of the last day of the fair without the consent of the President and General Superintendent.

All other exhibits remain the property of the exhibitor and may be removed after 4:00 pm the last day of the fair.

Any exhibit left after Wednesday will be disposed of by the Board.

All agricultural exhibits shall be with other exhibits of like kind, example: corn with corn, wheat with wheat.

In cases where no other person is competing the judges will award second or no premiums, as they deem best.

All stock must be owned by the exhibitor at least 30 days prior to the day of entry.

The age of all animals shall be computed from the last day of the month in which it was born.

Any article or animal fraudulently entered or shown that wins a premium if satisfactory proof is shown to the director's board, the premiums shall not be paid.

All premiums must be called for before the 1st of September each year or the same will be forfeited to the Association. All premiums will be paid in full unless by unavoidable cause the receipts shall not be sufficient, in which case they will be prorated and paid accordingly.

A blue ribbon denotes the first premium and a red ribbon second premium.

No animal or article not listed in the premium list will be entered for premium except as otherwise provided for.

All protests must be filed in writing with the Secretary during the fair, and the same will be acted upon at the first meeting of the board.

All articles must be entered just as you want them, for the rules will be strictly adhered to.

All years of operation, premiums have been paid in full.

Any type of protest, demonstration, or public display of group opinion will not be allowed on the fairgrounds without written permission from the Fair Board Violations will be removed from the fairgrounds.
